



OLYMPIAD DRIVE, ET AL.

ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT



Dear Neighbor:

The County of Los Angeles Department of Public Works is pleased to inform you of an upcoming roadway improvement project in your neighborhood.

Within the next few weeks, work will begin on Olympiad Drive in the unincorporated communities of View Park and Windsor Hills (see map on the reverse side). The project, which will be built at no cost to the adjacent property owners, will consist of resurfacing and reconstruction of the existing pavement; reconstruction of deteriorated curb and gutter, sidewalk, and driveways; and replacement of cross gutters. The project also includes removal of trees that are damaging the existing curb, gutter, and sidewalk. New trees will be planted at various locations. The work will be performed by Sequel Contractors, Inc., and is expected to take about 7 months to complete.

During construction, parking may be restricted and traffic will be delayed by large equipment and the delivery of materials to the jobsite. Temporary "NO PARKING" signs will be posted along the construction route at least 1 day prior to the arrival of the work crew to your area. During the construction hours between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., Parkglen Avenue and Northland Drive may be closed to through traffic, Enoro Drive may be closed at its intersection with Mount Vernon Drive, and Lorado Way may be closed at its intersection with Escalon Avenue. All other project streets may be reduced to one traffic lane for both directions, controlled by flaggers, during construction hours between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Adjacent streets may not be closed concurrently. Access to homes will be maintained by the contractor except for short periods of time when it is impractical to do so. Please observe all traffic controls, parking restrictions, and flagmen; exercise caution while in the vicinity of all construction activities.

Throughout construction, Public Works will have **Mr. Ali Dana**, Construction Supervisor, in charge of the project. 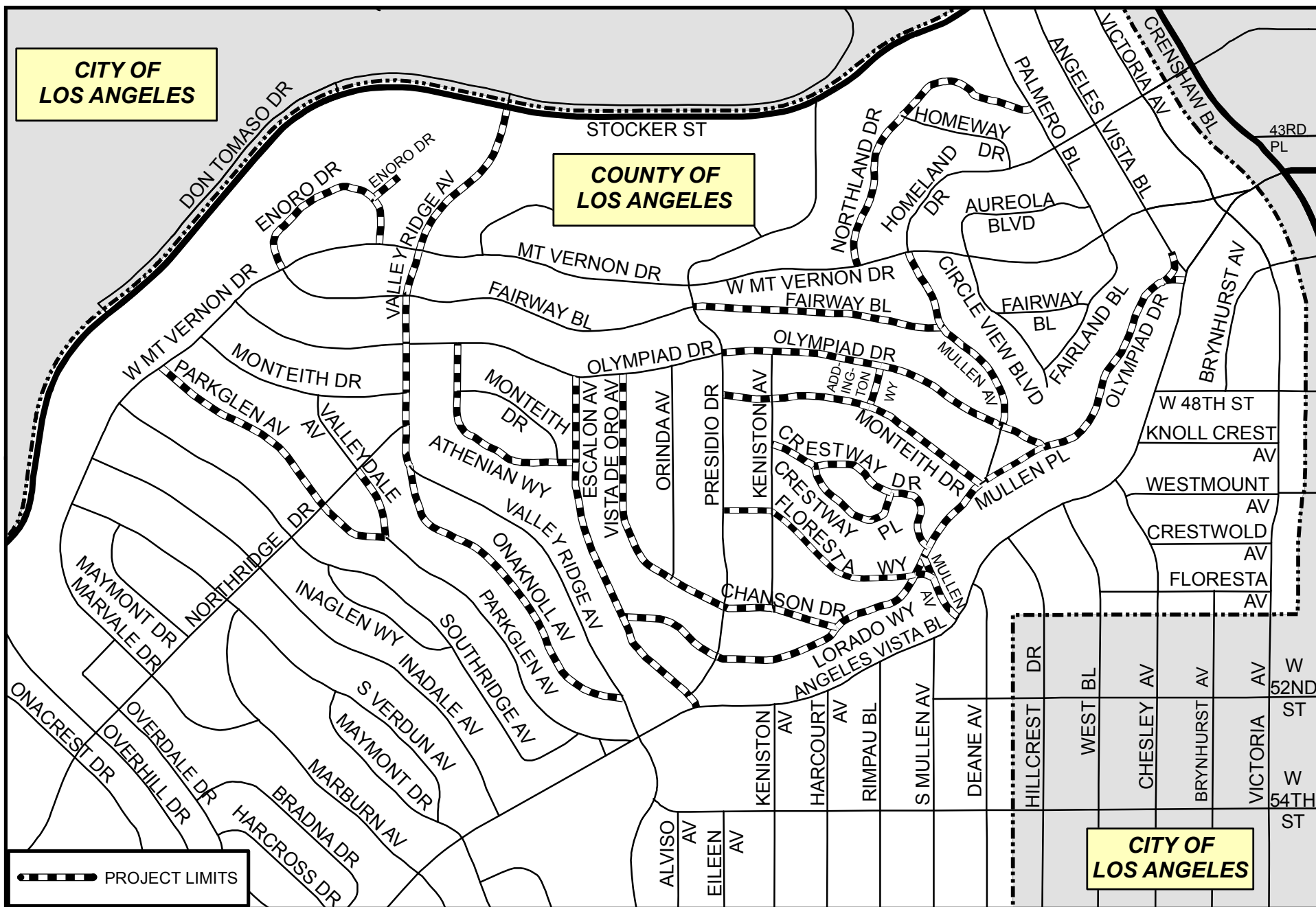
